SELECTION PROCESS FOR FOREIGN NON RESIDENTS IN BRAZIL REGULAR STUDENTS FOR THE PhD DEGREE OF THE GRADUATE PROGRAM IN GEOGRAPHY OF THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF CEARÁ - BRAZIL

The coordination of the Graduate Program in Geography (PPGG), of the Science Center of the Federal University of Ceará (UFC), calls for applications to fill up to 1 (one) open position for the Doctorate Course distributed according to the following thematic areas:

1. REGISTRATION

1.1 The registration of candidates is open from **August, 01 to August, 16** and consists of two procedures:

- Candidates must fill out the online electronic form available at the following website <http://www.si3.ufc.br/sigaa/public> (option “*Processos Seletivos Stricto Sensu*”)
- The required documents listed in Item 1.3 of this Call for Candidatures must be send to the PPGG secretariat electronic address (posgeog@ufc.br)¹ and must be inserted in the SIGAA.

1.2. This Public Notice 01/2023 follows the guidelines of Resolution 14/2013 /CEPE/UFC [link](<https://ppgern.ufc.br/wp-content/uploads/2019/02/00.resoluCAo-14-2013-cepe.pdf>)

concerning the essential conditions of:

- Clarity and resolution of digital copies (without erasures), eliminating the need for authentication (item III of Resolution 14/2013/CEPE/UFC);
- Only registration applications that are submitted with complete documentation and within the period specified in the notice and listed in Item xx will be accepted (item IV of this Resolution 14/2013 /CEPE/UFC);
- The entire text of the Research Project must not include the candidate's name to prevent identification by the members of the examining committee(s). Candidates who sign or insert any mark or signal that allows identification will be disqualified (item XV of Resolution 14/2013 /CEPE/UFC). Evaluation control is conducted using a random code.

1.3 The registration of the candidate is conditioned to the fulfilling of all requirements present at this call. The result indicating the acceptance or not of the registration will be provided by e-mail, being

the candidate entirely responsible for providing a valid e-mail at the online registration form of this call.

1.4 The candidate must send the following documents, in the sequence indicated below, compounded as a unique “.zip” file:

- a) Registration form (SIGAA form);
- b) Copy of valid passport;
- c) Copy of Master University degree or any valid document that replaces it;
- d) Curriculum Vitae
- e) Scores Form (Annex I);
- f) Confirmatory documents that proof the items mentioned in the Scores Form;
- g) Research proposal;

2. SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process will be conducted by a selection committee designated by PPGG coordinator and composed by 3 PPGG members: Jader de Oliveira Santos (president), Tiago Vieira Cavalcante and Carlos Iara Rafaela Gomes.

2.1 Evaluation Process (Curriculum Grade and Research Proposal): eliminatory and qualifying

The final grade (FG) of the candidate is expressed as the add of the Curriculum Grade (CG) with the Research Proposal (RPG). The minimum score will be 7.0 and the maximum will be 10.0.

2.1.1 Research Proposal (Note variation: 0 to 5)

The research proposal grade (RPG) has a weight of 50% on the total score and it is eliminatory and qualifying. On the proposal, the candidate must describe his/her acquaintance with the topic of the thematic area he/she is being a candidate for. Minimum score for eligibility is 2,5.

2.1.1 Curriculum Grade (Note variation: 0 to 5)

The curriculum grade (CG) has a weight of 50% on the total score, obeying the Scores Form in Annex I, and is eliminatory and qualifying. Minimum score for eligibility is 100 (Annex II).

3. RESULT

3.1 The final grade (FG) of the candidate is expressed as the add of the CG with the RPG. The minimum score will be 7.0 and the maximum will be 10.0.

3.2 Draws will be resolved by giving priority to the RPG note.

3.3 The final results will be published in decreasing order of the final calculated scores. The results will be indicated as follows: "approved and ranked", "approved but not ranked", or "failed"

3.4 The selection committee will publish the list of approved candidates, up to the vacancies limit, in descending order of FG, at <http://www.ppggeografia.ufc.br/>.

3.5 The approval in item 3.3 does not imply scholarship concession. Scholarships will be conceded according to specific call to be published at the end of this selection process, obeying the Internal Regulation of the PPGG.

3.6 The Result of the selection process will be published until **August 26, 2024** at the electronic website <http://www.si3.ufc.br/sigaa/public>, in a decreasing order of the total scores of the approved candidates.

3.7 Complaints about the results of this call must be placed to the PPGG coordination up to 5 days after the publication of the Results (until September 03). Candidates must be send an email (free format) to the PPGG secretariat electronic address (posgeog@ufc.br). The answer will be provided within 24 hours after filing the appeal (Resolução nº 17/CEPE, de 17/10/2016). The Final Result will be published at the **September 04, 2021**.

3.8 The confirmatory enrollment of the approved candidates must be concluded at the PPGG secretariat, by the candidate himself/herself or, alternatively, by an authorized party, in a future date to be indicated after the publication of the result.

3.9 It must be signed by the members of the board (s) before the start of the selection process, included in the minutes, declaration of existence of impediment or suspicion, under the terms of the current legislation, in relation to the candidates participating in the selection process.

3.10 Candidates are guaranteed, after disclosing the results of each eliminatory or eliminatory and classificatory stage, the right to appeal within two working days, due to legality and merit, without limiting the amount. The notices must contain the following information: dates for filing and responding to appeals, deadline for filing, place of delivery of the petition, definition of the way of forwarding and designation of the authority responsible for the decision, date of disclosure of the decision and form of communication of the decision to interested parties; (amended by Resolution No. 17 / CEPE, of 10/17/2016.

Professional experience in companies, teaching or research institutions	10 (per semester)
Courses completed as special or regular student in graduate programs	10 (for each 4 credits or 60 course hours)
Internacional exchange experience, internships or similar programs	10 (per semester)
<u>Observations:</u> - For academic or professional activities with duration exceeding 1 semester, the associated scores will be calculated proportionally to the number of months.
