



## Notice of Public Exam for the admission to the Doctoral Program at UFC

The Postgraduate Geography Program at Universidade Federal do Ceará announces the opening of a mission for public selection to fill up to thirteen (13) vacancies, Doctoral Program in Geography.

### 1. APPLICATIONS

1.1. Application period: From 03/28/2016 to 04/08/2016. Can apply people holding mastersdegree in Geography and / or areas and related sciences.

Applications must be performed online, via SIGAA <http://www.si3.ufc.br/sigaa/public> system (tab Selection processes Stricto sensu).

The candidates residing outside of Fortaleza may request enrollment by mail sent via *registered mail* with return receipt, posted until April 8, 2016.

1.2. Will not be accepted presential applications performed after the deadline and beyond the scheduled time.

1.3 Will be authorized: the applications delivered by mail, via *registered mail* with return receipt requested, within the specified time limit for performing presential applications.

1.4 Shall not be accepted: Applications made by mail that have the date of postage later than the given deadline for presential applications. The evidence that the applications delivered by mail were carried out by the deadline will be done by checking the DATE OF POSTING. .

1.5 Shall not be accepted: Applications made by mail that are not posted on the special delivery mode with return receipt requested. The post with receipt notice is required to ensure delivery on site at the Registry of Postgraduate Program.

1.6 The documentation sent to the posting date of the later Post the specified period will be discarded.

1.7 This program is not responsible for any candidate's documentation misplacement.

1.9. The absence of any of the documents requested, or improper disposal thereof, will disqualify the application of the candidate.

1.10. Only applications for registration that are with complete documentation and are forwarded within the period specified in the notice will be accepted. Note: the model curriculum lattes can be checked on the site [www.cnpq.br](http://www.cnpq.br) .

## 2. SELECTION PROCESS

The selection of candidates will be made by a Selection Committee, established by the permanent professors of the program, indicated by the Coordination and approved at a meeting of the Board, namely: Dr. Jader de Oliveira Santos (Chairman), Prof. Dr. Alexandre Queiroz Pereira (Member), Professor. Dr. Alexandra Maria de Oliveira (Member), Prof. Dr. Maria Elisa Zanella (member) and Prof.Dr. Edson Vicente da Silva (Member).

The selection process involves the following steps:

- (1) Written Knowledge Test (eliminary);
- (2) Analysis of the Project of Research (eliminary);
- (3) Analysis of Curriculum Lattes (classificatory).

The components Jury Selection Commission will meet the requirements of item VIII of Resolution 14 / ECE / 2013 . [http://www.ufc.br/images/\\_files/a\\_universidade/cepe/resolucao\\_cepe\\_2013/resolucao14\\_cepe\\_2013.pdf](http://www.ufc.br/images/_files/a_universidade/cepe/resolucao_cepe_2013/resolucao14_cepe_2013.pdf). The Selection Committee, however, may call other Program professors to collaborate in the evaluation process.

## **2.1 Written Knowledge Test (eliminary).**

Argumentative text in which the applicant must demonstrate mastery of knowledge in the area of concentration. Applicants must attend to the test, provided with the identity card and application receipt. The written test will be identified by number, so as not to allow the applicant's identification by the Selection Committee. The written test will consist of questions (general and specific, as the thematic lines) related to geographical theories, formulated from the bibliography provided (item 5 of this notice). Its realization will be given on a maximum of three hours and will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

## **2.2 Analysis of the Project of Research (eliminary)**

The project analysis will be performed according to the following criteria:

The minimum score required to pass the next step is 7.0 (seven), attributed the range 0.0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten), and the applicant can not obtain a score of zero on any of the criteria.

Disclosure of classified will be in descending order.

### **2.3 Academic Curriculum LATTES Assessment (classificatory).**

The curriculum analysis will be conducted respecting the supporting titles, as well as academic productivity, according to the following criteria:

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It will be the equivalence made by the sum of the amount of the points of the candidate's curriculum, considering the maximum score for the candidate who has the highest score, and the remaining notes prorated (simple rule of three).

### **3. ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS**

3.1 The administrative acts performed during the selection process, such as application and delivery of documents, can be carried out by proxies made by candidates by simple proxy.

3.2 Candidates with special needs may request special conditions for carrying out the tests selection.

3.3 is provided to applicants after the publication of the results of each classificatory and eliminatory stage, the right to a recourse within two (02) business days. The recourse must be prepared in a specific form (see program website) and delivered as within the Postgraduate Program of the Secretariat.

3.3.1. Candidates may obtain views of Written Test, holding the original identity document with photo and / or by proxy, through an application available on the Secretariat of the Program or <http://www.ppggeografia.ufc.br/index> site. Php / arquivos - formulários, provided they do so within the period specified in the schedule to this Notice. The request done after the deadline or not provided in the announcement form shall be dismissed.

3.3.2. Recourses may be lodged by the candidates, the hours of operation of the Programme Secretariat, through formal document containing:

- a) clear and precise formatting;
- b) a justification precise and concise resource reason;
- c) objective and readable presentation (preferably printed sheets);
- d) readable identification, signature of ID number, social security number and date.

3.3.3. The resources will be judged and their results will be released in two days on the bulletin board and the program's website, according to the timing of this announcement (Item 4).

3.4 It is provided to the applicant within five working days, from the date of publication of the final result for concerning recourses procedures, due to legality and merit, whose return time will be made within the same period.

3.5 The release of partial results will be given in time previously set on the calendar provided on this Notice. At each stage, the names of successful candidates, with their references or notes will be included.

3.6 The final score of the candidate will be calculated as the arithmetic average of the marks obtained in all the tests, as follows: Written Test (WT); Analysis of The Project of Research (AP); Analysis of Curriculum Lattes (CL):  $[(W \times 2) + (AP \times 2) + (CL \times 1)] / 5$

3.7 The tiebreaker is the highest score obtained in the project, then the highest grade obtained in the written test, and finally the highest score in the curriculum.

3.8 The disclosure of the final result, the applicants will be ordered in descending sequence of the final score obtained, observing the limit of expected vacancies in the Notice, showing the results as follows: "Approved and classified" or "approved, but not classified" or "failed". The final number of approved may be equal to or less than the number of vacancies established herein.

3.9 The availability of PhD scholarships (granted by the shares of CAPES and FUNCAP) shall be subject to quantitative program quotas, as well as the criteria established by the Grants Commission indicated by the Coordination of Postgraduate Geography, which only ensures access and grant is awarded studies enrolled to prove that all requirements for the procedures of the agencies, as the program of the Internal Regulations (see "Internal Rules" in <http://www.ppggeografia.ufc.br/>).

3.10 It is ensured the return of the documents during the process of selecting the rejected candidates or obtained rejection of registration within 40 days after publication of the final result of the selection, otherwise the documents will be forwarded to the UFC Recycling industry the Coordination

3.11 Issues not covered by this notice will be resolved by the Selection Committee with approval of the Coordination.
